SECURITY VIGILANCE

OVERVIEW. Rail employees play a vital role in protecting the U.S. rail network, as they account for most reports of suspicious activity in and around rail facilities. Remaining vigilant every day is a responsibility you have as a railroader and member of your community. You must also know what to do and what not to do in the event you see something.

VIGILANCE TIPS



LOOK for anything that seems out of place or out of the ordinary



FOCUS on bridges, tunnels, switches, and signal facilities



REPORT signs of tampering, suspicious objects or activity

REMAIN VIGILANT! YOU ARE THE FIRST LINE OF DEFENSE.

VIGILANCE DO'S & DON'TS Know what and what NOT to do if you see something!



- **CALL** 911 if in imminent danger
- **NOTIFY** your supervisor
- TAKE NOTES Descriptions and directions of travel for people and vehicles



- **TOUCH** or **APPROACH** a suspicious object or threatening person
- USE any electronic, cell, or radio equipment within 300 feet of a suspicious object
